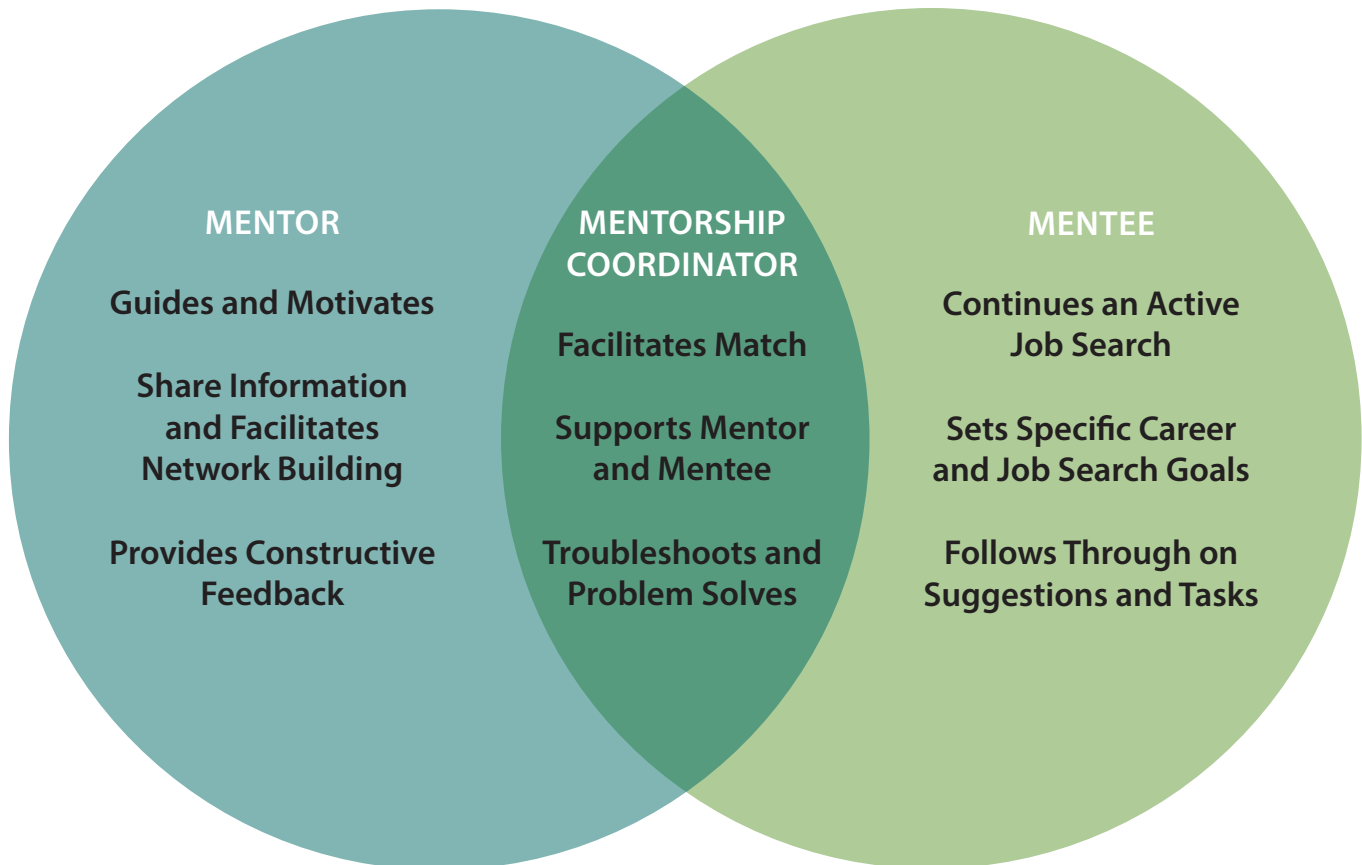


# The Mentoring Partnership
